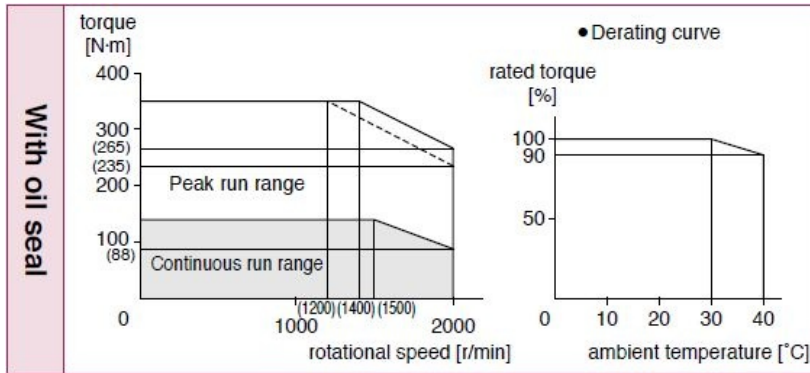

Torque characteristics

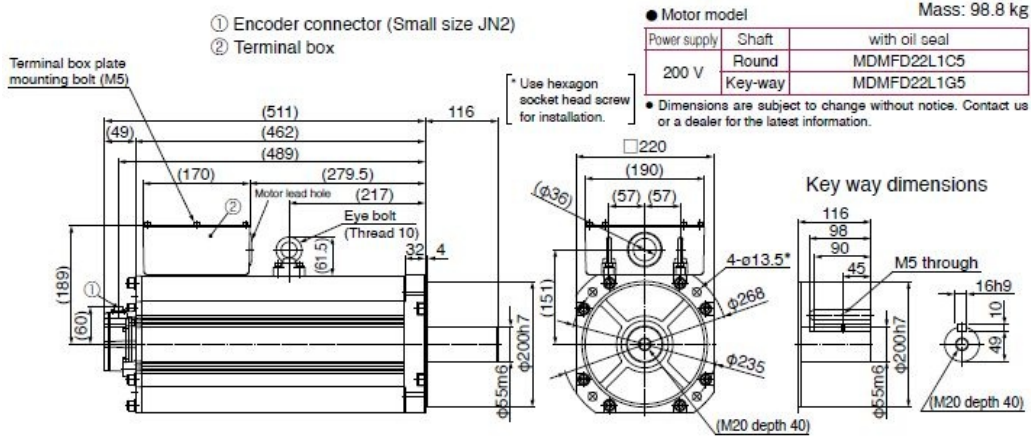


Dotted line represents the torque at 10 % less supply voltage.
